

Application for Acceptance into Graduate Schools at Kumamoto University as Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT) Scholarship (Embassy Recommendation) candidates

To those successful candidates who have passed the first stage of the selection process for Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT) scholarship (embassy recommendation) and who wish to gain permission of acceptance into Kumamoto University, please apply according to the instructions below.

1. Qualifications

Those who have officially passed the primary screening for Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT) scholarships at Japanese Embassy/Consulate General

2. Available Graduate Courses of Study

- (1) Graduate School of Education (Master's course)
- (2) Graduate School of Social and Cultural Sciences (Master's course and Doctoral course)
※Except Graduate School of Instructional Systems
- (3) Graduate School of Science and Technology (Master's course and Doctoral course)
- (4) Graduate School of Medical Sciences (Master's course and Doctoral course)
- (5) Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences (Master's course and Doctoral course)
- (6) Graduate School of Health Sciences (Master's course and Doctoral course)

3. Forms to Submit

- (1) The set of forms originally submitted to the Japanese Embassy/Consulate General (and that have the seal of the Japanese Embassy/Consulate General on them), which includes:
 - Application
 - Field of Study and Study Program
 - Academic transcript of each academic year of the last university attended
 - Recommendation from the principal or the adviser of the last university attended
 - Graduation certificate of the last university attended (or an attested document certifying that the applicant will graduate from the school, where applicable)
 - Certificate of degree
 - Medical certificate
 - Abstract of graduate thesis (necessary only for those intending to apply to enter a PhD course)
 - Photograph(s) showing your own works or art or a recorded tape of musical performance (necessary only for those majoring in fine arts or music)
- (2) "Passing Certificate of the Primary Screening" issued by a Japanese Embassy/Consulate General
- (3) Other forms or documents as requested by the educational department you are applying to enter
 - * Please inquiry for more details
 - * Note: In the case that any of the forms or documents written in a language other than Japanese or English, you must include a translated Japanese or English version of it along with the original.

4. Selection process

Decisions will be made by a committee at each graduate school based on a review of the materials submitted by each applicant and an internet interview when it is requested.

5. Deadline for Submission

- (1) All materials must be sent by August 31.
- (2) Be sure to send by email attachment (PDF file) or express mail (EMS, DHL).
- (3) If the size of attachment is more than 8M, please divide them and send us by several mails.

- (1) Materials received after the deadline date (August 31) will not be accepted for any reason.
- (2) The results of the selection process will be notified by email. Successful applicants will be sent a “Certificate of Enrollment” or a “Letter of Acceptance.”
- (3) Successful applicants should submit their “Certificate of Enrollment” or “Letter of Acceptance” to their Japanese Embassy/Consulate General by the date designated by the Japanese Embassy/Consulate General.
- (4) Confirmation of the content of academic classes and the selection of an academic advisor should be carried out by carefully reading the Kumamoto University homepage.
- (5) Any inquiries regarding the selection process will not be answered.
- (6) Personal information written on all relevant documents will only be used for the selection by Kumamoto University and will not be given out to any third parties.
