### 1. Qualifications

- (3) Graduate School of Science and Technology (Master's course and Doctoral course)
- (4) Graduate School of Medical Sciences (Master's course and Doctoral course)
- (5) Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences (Master's course and Doctoral course)
- (6) Graduate School of Health Sciences (Master's course and Doctoral course)

#### 3. Forms to Submit

- (1) The set of forms originally submitted to the Japanese Embassy/Consulate General (and that have the seal of the Japanese Embassy/Consulate General on them), which includes:
  - Application
  - Field of Study and Research Program Plan
  - · Academic transcript of each academic year of the last university attended
  - · Graduation certificate or degree certificate of the last university attended
  - · Recommendation from the principal or the adviser of the last university attended
  - Abstract of graduate thesis (only if submitted to the diplomatic mission)
  - Language ability certificate (only if submitted to the diplomatic mission)
  - Recommendation letter from the present employer (Submit if the applicant is currently employed.)
  - Photograph(s) showing your own works, art, or a recorded tape of musical performance (only if submitted to the diplomatic mission)
- (2) "Passing Certificate of the Primary Screening" issued by a Japanese Embassy/Consulate General
- (3) Other forms or documents as requested by the educational department you are applying to enter
  - \* Please inquiry for more details

\* Note: In the case that any of the forms or documents written in a language other than Japanese or English, you must include a translated Japanese or English version of it along with the original.

#### 4. Selection process

Decisions will be made by a committee at each graduate school based on a review of the materials submitted by each applicant and an internet interview when it is requested.

# 5. Deadline for Submission

- (1) All materials must be sent by August 24.
- (2) Be sure to send by email attachment (PDF file) or express mail (EMS, DHL).
- (3) If the size of attachment is more than 8MB, please divide them and send us by several mails.
