- Specify your main paper by © and your sub paper by ○; only published papers can be your main paper and sub paper.
- For joint papers, specify your contribution in details.

(3) Offprints or copies of main paper and sub paper, and a summary of each in 1,000 words: six copies each

(4) A summary of past research and educational activities in 2,000 words: six copies each

(5) Overview of planned research and educational activities after appointment in 2,000 words: six copies each

(1) The first round of selection: review of written applications/documents

(2) The second round of selection: interview

- Candidates selected for an interview will be contacted via email or phone call individually to inform them of the details of the interview. The interview will be conducted online (via Zoom).
